ISLAND-INSPIRED SPIRITS

The tiki renaissance has sparked our taste for tropical flavors, but coconut and pineapple have remained neglected on the liquor shelf. Yes, there are flavored spirits that all too often evoke the essence of sunscreen, but products that exude honest coconut or pineapple flavors have

eluded us—until now. Late last year, Rhum Clément introduced Mahina Coco liqueur—a mix of rum agricole and young coconut—with plans for further rollouts in coming months. And last summer, Plantation Rum introduced Stiggins' Fancy, a rum crafted in collaboration with David Wondrich that adds distilled pineapple to aged rum along with an infusion of fresh fruit; limited amounts should be available by summer.
