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Burnt orange color; impeccable purity. Wow, there's all sorts of aromatic activity going on here the opening fragrance, including of black traces peppercorn, clove, cinnamon, baked cherry, prune Danish, molasses; later sniffs pick up vegetation/forest, leaves, black tea, dry stone/slate. Entry is fruity (white raisins, dried off-dry, pineapple), brown sugar-like; midpalate is peppery, piquant, minerally, drier than the entry. Ends fruity, spicy, full of charm. Excellent value.
